Minutes of the Meeting Merch 29, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Smith at 10:00 a.m., March 29, 1963, with all members present except Senators Farmer, Hults, and Van Sickle.

Senator Ward presented the subcommittee report on House Bill No. 438. The purpose of the bill is to reduce fees charged by the Board of Cosmetology thereby limiting the reserve fund. He moved that House Bill No. 438 be recommended for passage. Senator Warren seconded the motion; motion carried.

Senator Saar presented the subcommittee report on House Bill No. 442. He moved that House Bill No. 442 be recommended for passage. Senator Sanborn seconded the motion; motion carried.

Senator Sanborn presented the subcommittee report on House Bill No. 443. He moved that it be amended in Section 10, line 2, by striking the words "under the Laws of Kansas" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "by the Kansas wheat act". Senator Smith seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Harper then moved that House Bill No. 443 be recommended for passage as amended. Senator Sanborn seconded the motion. Motion carried.
