SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting April 5, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 9:30 a.m., April 5, 1963. All members were present except Senators Hults and Van Sickle.

Senator Glades presented the subcommittee's report concerning House Bill 447. It was noted that the section included for the Industrial School for Boys appropriated money from the State charitable institutions and mental hospitals building fund; and this was the first time an appropriation from the fund had been made to institutions other than mental hospitals. An Attorney General opinion sanctioned the appropriation.

Senator Glades moved that an amendment be made to House Bill 447, section 7, line 5, to correct a clerical error, by striking "76-6605" and inserting in lieu thereof "76-6b05". Senator Sanborn seconded the motion; motion carried. Thereupon, Senator Harper moved, and Senator Farmer seconded the motion, that House Bill 447 be recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried.

After a brief discussion, Senator Glades made a motion that House Bill 449 be recommended for passage. Senator Ward seconded the motion; motion carried.

Chairman Smith reported that the Revisor of Statutes had approached the House Committee for authorization to pay an additional 20 percent in salaries to their personnel for additional work involved in a printing project. Senator Farmer moved, and Senator Warren seconded the motion, that the Chairman report to the House Committee that this committee voted there should not be a 20 percent salary increase allowed for the staff of the Revisor of Statutes to complete a publications job. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
