The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 10:00 a.m. on February 4, 1964. All members were present.

A discussion was held of Senate Bill 19 which had been referred to the committee for recommendation. (Att. 1)

It was noted that this was against the usual policy of the committee of appropriating more to an agency than had been requested, in this case, the Board of Regents.

It was noted that authority had been given to the Regents to enter into a reciprocal agreement for the education of dental students in other states and that so far they have stated they are two years away from culminating such an agreement.

It was moved by Senator Jones and seconded by Senator Harper that the bill be amended and recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried. Senator Farmer abstained. (See Att. 2)
