SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting February 8, 1964

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Smith on February 8, 1964. All members were present. Also present was Mr. Bibb, Budget Director.

Senator Smith noted amendments which had been made to Senate bills in the House of Representatives which would probably require conference committees.

The committee considered House Bill 23 which had been referred to the committee for recommendation. It was moved by Senator Hults and seconded by Senator Jones that HOUSE BILL 23 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

The committee considered House Bill 24 which had been referred to the committee for recommendation. Senator Warren and Senator Jones reported on section 4, dealing with the budget of the State Board of Health. The primary deletion made in this budget by the House of Representatives, was \$11,343 for a Chief Attorney classification.

Following a discussion of the above matter, it was moved by Senator Farmer that the position be reinstated at \$10,500. Senator Jones made a substitute motion that it be reinstated as recommended by the Governor. The motion was seconded by Senator Harper; the motion failed.

Senator Farmer repeated his original motion that the position be reinstated at \$10,500 and the motion was seconded by Senator Hults. The motion carried.

Senator Smith reported on all other sections of the bill dealing with the agencies under the Division of Institutional Management.

It was moved by Senator Farmer and seconded by Senator Harper that HOUSE BILL 24 be recommended for passage as amended in section 4. The motion carried.

The meeting recessed at 10:00 a.m.
