Minutes of the Meeting January 25, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m., January 25, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present except Senators Bowers and Saar.

Senator Smith recommended that the Committee present a bill for consideration of the Legislature to allow funds for the replacement of equipment and consumable supplies and repair and restoration of certain buildings and services at the Kansas State University at Manhattan, and at the State Industrial Reformatory at Hutchinson. Thereupon, he made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that a Committee bill be introduced to allow the following funds for fiscal year 1965:

General Fund:

Kansas State University \$253,000 State Industrial Reformatory 15,000
