SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting March 2, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., March 2, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members of the Committee were present.

Attention was called to House Bills Nos. 620 and 628 were on general orders for the day, and Senators Saar and Bell were asked to carry the bills.

Senator Van Sickle submitted subcommittee reports concerning the Eisenhower Presidential Library Commission and the Kansas Civil War Commission appropriations. (See copies attached.) Senator Van Sickle then made a motion that the subcommittee reports be adopted by the Committee, and appropriate bills be drawn and introduced in the Senate with the recommendation that they be passed. Senator Bell seconded the motion; and the motion carried.

The Chairman then recommended that the Committee act upon a proposal to purchase files for the use of Senate members. A motion was made by Senator Van Sickle, seconded by Senator Warren, to purchase 38 two-drawer, legal size, metal files with locks, each file to be equipped with alphabetical index tabs, and 100 corrugated board storage files (see file of Senator Arthur), said metal files to be purchased through the competitive bid process in the State Purchasing Division. The motion carried.

A proposed bill was discussed by Senator Van Sickle which makes appropriations to the Adjutant General's Department, Kansas National Livestock Brand Commission, and the Forestry, Fish and Game Commission, which incorporates recommendations made by the Committee. Senator Van Sickle moved that the bill be introduced as a Committee bill with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator Bowers seconded the motion. Motion carried. (See copy of Bill attached.)

A copy of a report on the Transportation of Executive Personnel by Non-Scheduled Aircraft, prepared by the Budget Division, was handed to each member for consideration.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
