## Minutes of the Meeting March 8, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., March 8, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present.

Senator Ward presented his subcommittee's report on the grants to the Veterans of Foreign War I, American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, United Spanish War Veterans, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. (See copy of report attached.) Senator Ward then moved that the subcommittee report be adopted and its recommendations incorporated in an appropriation bill to be introduced by the Committee. Senator Warren seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Warren presented a subcommittee report on the Kansas Public Employees Retirement System. (See copy attached.) Senator Warren moved that the report be adopted and its recommendations incorporated in an appropriation bill to be introduced by the Committee. Senator Saar seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Saar presented a subcommittee report on the Nuclear Energy Advisory Council. (See copy attached.) Senator Saar moved that the report be adopted and its recommendations incorporated in an appropriation bill to be introduced by the Committee. Senator Arthur seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Warren presented a subcommittee report on the Brand Commissioner. (See copy attached.) He moved that the report be adopted and its recommendations incorporated in an appropriation bill to be introduced by the Committee. Senator Bell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Ward presented the subcommittee report on the Commission on Civil Rights. (See copy attached.) He moved that the report be adopted and the recommendations incorporated in an appropriation bill to be introduced by the Committee. Senator Van Sickle seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Warren moved that a bill be prepared and introduced to include the Committee's recommended appropriations to the Eisenhower Presidential Library Commission; Historical Society; the grants to the Veterans of Foreign War I, American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, United Spanish War Veterans; Veterans of Foreign Wars; Kansas Public Employees Retirement System; Nuclear Energy Advisory Council; Brand Commission; and the Commission on Civil Rights. Senator Bell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Bowers then moved that a Committee bill be introduced authorizing the leasing of approximately 22 acres of land situated at the John Brown Memorial Park. (See copy of bill attached.) Senator Van Sickle seconded the motion. Motion carried.
