

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting  
March 12, 1965

Senator Saar presented the subcommittee report on HOUSE BILL 887 wherein he stated that the subcommittee concurs with the House recommendations. He moved that House Bill 887 be reported back with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator Bowers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Bell presented his subcommittee's report on the SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION. (See copy attached.) Thereupon he moved that the subcommittee report be adopted and its recommendations incorporated in a Committee appropriation bill to be introduced. Senator Arthur seconded the motion. Motion carried.
