## SPECIAL JOINT COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE FACILITIES

All members of the Committee were present.

The Committee reviewed the results of the computer search of the Kansas statutes with emphasis on those laws that would require changes to implement the annual sessions amendment. Generally the Committee recommended that some of the statutes should be referred to standing committees of the legislature, that some required no changes and that certain bills introduced thus far in 1967 would serve to make some of the needed changes.

Representative Van Cleave requested that the legislature be asked to consider K.S.A. 75-3721 in terms of the time allowed a Governor to deliver his message to the legislature in even numbered years. The Committee includes this section in its report for consideration by the two Ways and Means Committees.

The Committee will also report to the legislature its recommendations for improved telephone service to the legislature.
