LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS

The 1966 special session of the legislature submitted a proposed constitutional amendment providing for annual regular sessions of the legislature. This amendment was adopted on November 8, 1966. Numerous sections of the statutes refer to general sessions, regular sessions, budget sessions, etc. These laws need to be carefully examined and a determination made as to the sections requiring changes. A search of the Kansas Statutes by computer was made in 1966 to provide a list of the sections of the Kansas statutes which refer to sessions of the legislature. This list of statutes will provide the committees with the materials to determine the changes which may be indicated or from which recommendations can be made.
