## Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION providing for the selection of a special joint committee on legislative facilities by the Senate and House of Representatives and prescribing the duties thereof.
- 1 Whereas, The 1966 Budget Session of the Legislature by the
- 2 adoption of House concurrent resolution No. 506 directed the
- 3 Kansas Legislative Council to make a study concerning physical
- 4 facilities, equipment, and staff and office procedures for members
- 5 of the legislature; and
- 6 Whereas, Under 1966 council Proposal No. 38, such a study was
- 7 made and a final report with recommendations was submitted to this
- 8 1967 session of the legislature; and
- 9 Whereas, One of the key recommendations of this report was
- 10 that a special joint committee of the House and Senate be created
- 11 to study and make recommendations on improvements concerning
- 12 legislative facilities, both short- and long-range, with recommenda-
- 13 tions for careful consideration to specific questions: Now, therefore,
- Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Kansas, the House of
- Representatives concurring therein: That a joint committee on legislative facilities to be composed of four (4) members of the House
- and three (3) members of the Senate be appointed to serve during
- the calendar years 1967 and 1968. The joint committee shall meet
- as soon as the members from both houses are appointed with the
- 20 first representative appointed serving as acting chairman. The com-
- 21 mittee shall then select a chairman and vice-chairman, who shall
- 22 not be members of the same house. Officers shall be selected for

the two-year term for which the committee is established. 1 vacancy shall occur on the committee, it shall be filled in the same 2 manner as a vacancy is filled on a standing committee in the House 3 or Senate, as the case may be. Thereafter, the committe shall meet 4 at such times as the committee shall determine and at the call of 5 6 the chairman. It shall be the duty of the point committee on legislative facilities 7 to make studies, and provide reports with recommendations thereon 8 to the legislature, concerning the facilities and staffing, and the 9 organization and operation of the legislature, including any changes 10 deemed necessary to implement the 1966 annual legislative sessions 11 amendment to the Kansas Constitution (Art. 2, § 25). 12 Whenever a particular phase of such study is completed and the 13 committee has agreed to its recommendations thereon, the com-14 mittee shall immediately report such recommendations to the Senate 15 and the House of Representatives. 16 Be it further resolved: That the secretary of the senate be directed 17 to deliver a copy of this resolution to each member of the Senate 18 appointed to this committee and the chief clerk of the house be 19

directed to deliver a copy to each member of the House of Repre-

sentatives appointed to this committee.
