

FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

February 5, 1969

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman with 18 members present. The Chairman called for discussion regarding H.B. 1060.

After discussion, Rep. Turner moved that it be reported favorably. Motion was seconded by Mr. Keenan but the motion failed with a vote of 8 in favor and 9 opposed. Thereupon, Mr. Brown moved that the bill be reported adversely. Motion was seconded by Mr. Harper and carried 10 to 0.

House Joint Resolution 1001 was then discussed and upon motion by Rep. Buchele and second by Rep. Andrews that same be reported adversely, the Resolution was so reported by a 13 to 1 vote.

HCR 1005 was then amended by unanimous vote and reported favorably as amended by a unanimous vote. Motion to amend by Mr. Mikesic and second by Mr. Keenan was unanimously accepted. The motion to report favorably as amended was made by Mr. Turner and seconded by Mr. Woodward.
