## FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

## February 24, 1969

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman who introduced Rep. Howard to discuss HCR 1014. Mr. Howard stated that this Resolution asks a Council study in connection with juvenile facilities; that in recent years there has been quite a problem with 16 and 17 year old juveniles; that in his city they have a facility that is rapidly being outgrown; and that there are from time to time certain facilities being abandoned that could possibly be utilized and that is why the study is being requested. He stated that his entire delegation supports this Resolution.

Mr. Linde appeared to discuss H.B. 1340. He was accompanied by Dr. Mort Morris who supports this proposal. Mr. Linde explained that there is now a Kansas Research Foundation and this bill proposes to replace it with a Kansas Department of Science and Technology. He stated that the former had not been everything that had been hoped for but that the latter would be a good channel for receiving federal and other grants for research purposes; that the potential for a Research Foundation is too great to be thrown away. He stated that the Foundation now does not have authority to go out and solicit funds and this prevents moving ahead as rapidly as should be done.

The Chairman called for discussion on H.B. 1038, and upon motion and second that it be reported adversely, the motion carried unanimously.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously carried that H.B. 1049 be reported adversely.

It was moved and seconded that H.B. 1220 be recommended favorable for passage. Motion was seconded and carried 16-0.

It was moved, seconded and carried unanimously that  $\text{H.B.}\ 1228$  be reported adversely and that  $\text{HCR}\ 1020$  requesting a Council study go directly to the Committee of the Whole.

It was moved, seconded and carried unanimously that HB 1134 be reported adversely, and that HCR 1019 on this subject be recommended directly to the Committee of the Whole. Mr. Turner's sub-committee report on this matter was adopted. See attached.
