

FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

April 11, 1969

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman who introduced Representative Loux to discuss HB 1404. Mr. Loux explained that this was introduced at the request of the Director of Institutions and that the Senate had already budgeted for this law enforcement training. He stated that it deals with the security officers at the institutions. Mr. Turner expressed the opinion that in case of emergency it would be nice to have these people trained.

Mr. Everett moved that the bill be recommended for passage, which motion was seconded by Mr. Buchele and carried unanimously.

The Chairman handed out packets of material which he explained would be matters the Committee would study at an interim meeting to be called at a later date.
