The meeting was called to order by the Chairman who stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the possibility of introducing a Fair Housing Bill, explaining that the bill he had before him was exactly the same as Senate Bill 16 left the Committee. He stated that in light of the Senate's unwillingness to go along with the amendments, it would show good faith if the bill is introduced and studied in the interim.

Mr. McCray stated that he wouldn't want anyone to get the wrong opinion about this and the Chairman stated that no action would be taken except to refer the bill to Committee where it would be ready to work on next year.

Mr. McGill moved that the bill be introduced, which motion was seconded by Mr. Ungerer and carried unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned.
