

ROADS AND HIGHWAYS COMMITTEE MEETING -- February 18, 1970

The Roads and Highways Committee met in room 535 at 2:45 P. M. on February 18, 1970. Chairman Dierdorff called the meeting to order and all members were present.

Guests present were: Dale Lyon, Athol, Farmers Union; Glenn Coulter, Topeka, Kansas Consulting Engineers; Joe Bailey, Wichita Area Chamber of Commerce; Glen Dockey, Wichita; Clifton L. Hess, Wichita; Paul Fleener, Manhattan, Kansas Farm Bureau, Kenneth Kern, Topeka, Finance Commissioner; Jim Love, Topeka, Water Commissioner.

Dr. James Drury was a conferee.

HOUSE BILL 1768 - AN ACT providing for the payment of state motor fuel and state special fuel taxes collected on turnpike projects to the Kansas turnpike authority; prescribing the duties of certain state officers in connection therewith and prescribing the uses of the moneys received by the authority; making certain acts unlawful and prescribing penalties.

Mr. Lutz made a motion, second by Mr. Nowlin, that HB 1768 be reported adversely. Motion lost - 10-8. (NO -- Ratner, Davis, Gray, Hayes, Holmes, Hughes, Jacobs, Lady, Madden, Mills; YES -- Kay, Long, Lutz, Nowlin, Powell, Spotts, Talkington, Wilcox. (Mr. Lady first voted yes and asked that his vote be changed to no.)

Mr. Hayes made a motion, second by Mr. Holmes, that HB 1768 be reported favorably. Motion lost - 8-7. (NO -- Kay, Long, Lutz, Nowlin, Powell, Spotts, Talkington, Wilcox; YES -- Davis, Ratner, Hayes, Holmes, Lady, Madden, Mills; PASS -- Dempsey,

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Gray, Hughes, Jacobs, Rosenau.)

Mr. Wilcox made a motion, second by Mr. Madden, that HB 1768 be tabled. Motion carried.

HOUSE BILL 1747 - AN ACT providing for the apportionment, distribution and expenditure of certain moneys for construction of roads and highways;...

In reporting for the sub-committee, Mr. Ratner said that they had agreed to disagree. They were unable to come up with a compromise on which they could all agree. He distributed charts to the members showing additional factors that Dr. Drury worked out - one on the basis of 1/3 on local rural road mileage; 1/3 on motor vehicle registrations; 1/3 on average daily vehicle miles, plus \$10,000 lump sum; another with \$15,000 lump sum. (See chart #1 which is attached.) For the most part they agreed that giving any grant on a population basis was not a practical approach. What they were looking at, basically, were the four or five counties that would be getting less. The goal was to get a unanimous recommendation but they were unable to do that.

After discussion on the proposals, Mr. Hayes made a motion that House Bill 1747 be amended on page 13, by striking all of lines 8 and 9; in line 10 by striking "(50%)" and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "One-third (1/3) thereof shall be apportioned and paid to each county in the proportion that the number of miles of county roads within such county bears to the total number of miles of county roads located in all counties of the state, but such road mileage

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shall not include the number of miles of interstate and state highways located in any county; Second, One-third (1/3)"; in line 15, by striking "fifty percent (50%) of such balance" and inserting in lieu thereof "one-third (1/3) thereof"; in line 25, by striking "fifty percent (50%)" and inserting in lieu thereof "fifty-five percent (55%)";

Mr. Hayes said that he would like an amendment that Mr. Lady has prepared be integrated into his amendment.

Mr. Lady's amendment is as follows: On page 13, in line 19, by inserting after "year" the following: ":" Provided, That each county shall receive at least two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) plus an amount equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the total amount received by such county and each city located within such county from the county road and city street fund, the county and township road fund and the special motor carrier fee county road fund during the period from July 1, 1968, to July 1, 1969";

Mr. Kay gave the second to the motion.

Mr. Long made a substitute motion that on page 13, line 8, the bill be amended by striking "five thousand"; in line in line 9, by striking "dollars (\$5,000) and inserting in lieu thereof "three thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$3,750)"; also in line 9, by striking "fifty" and inserting in lieu thereof "thirty-three and one-third"; in line 10, by striking "(50%)" and inserting "(33-1/3%)"; in line 15, by striking "The remaining fifty percent (50%)" and inserting "Thirty-three and one-third percent (33-1/3%)"; in line 19, by striking

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the period and inserting in lieu thereof "; thirty-three and one-third percent (33-1/3%) thereof shall be apportioned and paid to each county in the proportion that the local rural road mileage and secondary road mileage within such county bears to the total of all local rural road mileage and secondary road mileage in all counties of the state.";

Mr. Lutz made the second to the motion. By a roll call vote it lost by a vote of 8-6. NO -- Ratner, Davis, Dempsey, Hayes, Holmes, Kay, Lady, Mills; YES -- Jacobs, Long, Lutz, Nowlin, Spotts, Wilcox; PASS -- Gray, Hughes, Madden, Powell, Rosenau, Talkington.

Mr. Hayes renewed his original motion.

Mr. Powell made a substitute motion that House Bill 1747 be tabled. Mr. Gray made the second to the motion. The motion lost by a vote of 11-9. NO -- Ratner, Davis, Dempsey, Hayes, Holmes, Kay, Lady, Madden, Mills, Rosenau, Talkington; YES -- Gray, Hughes, Jacobs, Long, Lutz, Nowlin, Powell, Spotts, Wilcox.

Mr. Hayes renewed his motion, second by Mr. Madden, that House Bill 1747 be amended as proposed by Hayes and Lady. The motion carried by a vote of 11-7. YES -- Ratner, Davis, Dempsey, Hayes, Holmes, Hughes, Kay, Lady, Madden, Mills, Talkington; NO -- Jacobs, Long, Lutz, Nowlin, Powell, Spotts, Wilcox; PASS -- Gray and Rosenau.

Mr. Hayes made a motion, second by Mr. Madden, that House Bill 1747 be reported favorably as amended. Motion carried by a vote of 11-7. The vote was exactly the same as above on the amendment.

HOUSE BILL 1640 - AN ACT relating to the sale, offer to sell or use of certain recut or regrooved tires; and defining certain crimes in connection therewith.

Mr. Garrett explained the bill and said that he would like to recommend that it be amended on line 2, after the word "any" by inserting the word "private".

No action was taken on HB 1640.
