## MINUTES

## LEGISLATIVE SERVICES AND FACILITIES

The Joint Committee on Legislative Services and Facilities met in the Senate Ways and Means Room on February 6, 1970, at 8:30 a.m. All members except Senators Harder and Warren, and Representative Loux were present.

Chairman Doyen called the meeting to order. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss SB 552.

Senator Doyen stated that there were some further assignments to the Committee with regard to SB 552. He further stated that he had received written criticism of this bill from various sources. He was of the opinion that a hearing should be scheduled, at which time the opponents, as well as the proponents, would be heard. Senator Doyen will set up such a meeting and notify interested parties. He stated that one or more members of the Supreme Court, or someone they would designate, would be invited to appear at the hearing.

It was brought up for Committee discussion as to the possibility of having another position under the supervision of Mr. William Bachman, to help with some of the maintenance and inventory that was planned in the months after the session adjourns.

After considerable discussion, it was felt that Mr. John Webb,
who had been relieved of his duties with Buildings and Grounds, could
fill this position. It was suggested that the two chairmen get together
and draw up the specifications. Mr. Webb would assist Mr. Bachman in
the observation of space utilization, room assignments, etc. during
the present legislative session, and would make recommendations as to
more efficient operation for the 1971 session. Mr. Webb was to be
advised that he would begin work on Monday, February 16 record as otherwise noted, the individual remarks
