## SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE FEBRUARY 11, 1970 ROOM 523

The Senate Judiciary Committee met February 11, 1970 in Room 523 at eleven o'clock A.M. with the chairman, Senator Steadman Ball, presiding. All members were present except Senators Foster, Gaar, Herd, Hodge, Steineger, and Van Sickle.

Senate Bill No. 592 was first considered. Senator Smith moved that the bill be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator Woodard seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Smith explained Senate Bill No. 492 and stated that it was introduced at the request of the Kansas University Medical Center. He moved that the bill be recommended for passage. Senator Storey seconded and the motion carried.

Senate Bill No. 484 was taken up. Senator Woodard moved that the bill be recommended not for passage. Senator Bennett seconded. No action was taken.

Senator Smith and Senator Bennett explained Senate Bill
No. 512. Senator Smith moved that the bill be reported back
to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator
Bennett seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Winter led the discussion of Senate Bill No. 514. He said that while the probate judges of Franklin County were anxious to have it passed, that Judge Copeland was also in favor of it. Senator Winter moved that the bill be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator Bennett seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Smith stated he was not yet ready to report for his subcommittee on Senate Bill No. 404 but hoped to be able to by Friday of this week.

After a discussion, it was decided to further consider Senate Bill No. 497.

After much discussion and a number of suggested amendments, Senator Bennett moved that the chairman be authorized to have the amendments for the bill drawn. Senator Storey seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Ball read (in part) and explained Senate Bill No. 485. Senator Bennett moved to strike Sec. 5 and renumber the remaining sections. Senator Healy seconded. Senator Ball appointed Senators Rogers, Storey and Bell to go over this bill and report back to the full committee.

The meeting adjourned.
