

SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

FEBRUARY 12, 1970

ROOM 523

The Senate Judiciary Committee met February 12, 1970 in Room 523 at eleven o'clock A.M. with the chairman, Senator Steadman Ball, presiding. All members were present except Senators Gaar, Van Sickle and Woodard.

Senate Bill No. 555 was taken up and Senator Pomeroy moved that the bill be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed. Senator Tillotson seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Ball explained Senate Bill No. 610. Senator Steineger moved that the committee recommend the bill for passage. Senator Foster seconded and the bill was reported favorably to the Senate.

Senator Smith gave a brief explanation of Senate Bill No. 468 and Fred Carman explained the bill section by section. He passed out two sheets of Supreme Court cases, copies of which are attached hereto and made a part of these minutes. Senator Bennett offered an amendment and moved the committee adopt same. Senator Smith seconded and the amendment was adopted by a unanimous vote. Another amendment on page 5 was necessary because the word "council" needed to be the word "counsel". Senator Smith moved that the bill be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed as amended; Senator Tillotson seconded and the motion carried.

Mr. John Decker, City Attorney of Wichita was present and talked on Senate Bill No. 522.


Senator Arvin reported on Senate Bill No. 578 and presented the amendment together with the prepared report which was accepted by the committee and reported favorably back to the

Senate.

The meeting adjourned to meet Friday, February 13, 1970.
