The Senate Judiciary Committee met February 25, 1970 in Room 523 at eleven o'clock A.M. with the chairman, Senator Steadman Ball presiding. All members were present except Senator Hodge. XXXXXXXXXXXXX

A group composed of ladies of the League of Women Voters was present to observe. They were residents of Johnson County, Kansas. Richard Neiderhauser, a senior law student, was also present to observe.

House Bill No. 1963 was discussed and compared with Senate Bill No. 610 which this committee had already reported favorably. Senator Storey moved that HB 1963 be recommended for passage. Senator Rogers seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Bennett moved that House Bill No. 1796 be recommended for passage, Senator Storey seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Smith told the history and practicality of House Concurrent Resolution No. 1033 which included raising the number of amendments to five instead of three. He moved and Senator Bennett seconded that the Resolution be recommended for adoption. The motion carried and was held for a tentative hearing at the next meeting.

Senator Smith told the committee that his subcommittee on Senate Bill No. 404 would be ready to report on February 26, 1970.
