

SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

ROOM 523

March 10, 1970

The Senate Judiciary Committee met in Room 523 March 10, 1970 at eleven o'clock A.M. with the chairman, Senator Steadman Ball, presiding. Members absent were Senators Bennett, Foster, Gaar, Smith, Storey and Woodard.

House Bill No. 1785, previously discussed, was explained by Rep. Bell, the author. He stated he thought Sec. 60-516 is discriminatory. Senator Pomeroy moved the bill be amended as per attached copy, Senator Arvin Seconded and the motion carried. Senator Arvin then moved the bill be recommended for passage as amended, Senator Healy seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Healy moved to reconsider House Bill No. 1843 which the committee had voted the day before to report unfavorably. Senator Herd spoke briefly on the merits of the bill. A discussion involving Senators Hodge, Arvin, Pomeroy, Ball and Healy followed. Senator Pomeroy looked up the present law. Senator Pomeroy seconded Senator Healy's motion to reconsider and the motion carried 5 to 3. Senator Pomeroy moved to omit lines 4 and 5 on page 3. Senator Healy seconded and the motion carried. The committee decided to hold the bill until the next meeting.

Senator Pomeroy explained that House Bill No. 1987 was designed to resolve a local matter and asked permission to check more details.

Senator Pomeroy moved that House Bill No. 1988 be recommended for passage by the committee, Senator Arvin seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Tillotson stated that he thought line 13 in House Bill No. 1853 was questionable. Senator Arvin moved the bill be recommended to the Senate for passage, Senator Pomeroy seconded and the motion carried.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 1026 was taken up and Senator Herd moved that it be reported back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be adopted. Senator Bell seconded. Senator Arvin made a substitute motion that it be passed over and set down for discussion at a certain time the next meeting. Senator Ball said it would be a special order of business on March 11, 1970.

Regarding House Bill No. 1887, Mr. Chaney was to be asked to appear in committee March 11 to explain the bill.

Senator Arvin moved that House Bill No. 1998 be recommended for passage, Senator Tillotson seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved that House Bill No. 2002 be recommended for passage, Senator Rogers seconded and the motion carried.

Senator Pomeroy moved that House Bill No. 1984 be reported unfavorably, and Senator Arvin seconded.


Senator Winter made a substitute motion that the bill be recommended for passage, Senator Rogers seconded and House Bill No. 1984 was recommended for passage.

Recommends that House Bill No. 1887 by Mr. Chaney

"AN ACT relating to tax foreclosures; concerning the sale and redemption of property; amending K. S. A. 79-2401a and 79-2801 and repealing the existing sections."

Be amended on page 1, by striking all of lines 1 to 20, inclusive;

On page 2, by striking all of lines 1 and 2;

And by renumbering original sections 2 to 5, inclusive, as sections 1 to 4, respectively;

Also on page 2, in line 7, by striking the word "second" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "third";

On page 3, in line 20, by inserting the words "cause to be" after the word "first";

On page 4, in line 12, by inserting after the word "owner" the following: ", spouse of owner,";

On page 4, in line 18, by striking "79-2401a and"; also in line 18, by striking "are" and inserting in lieu thereof "is";

In the title in line 2 by striking "79-2401a and"; and in line 3, by striking the word "sections and inserting in lieu thereof the word "section";

And the bill be passed as amended.
