Subcommittee C

Senator Bennett, Chairman; Senator Winter, Vice-chairman; Senators Rogers, Steineger, Smith, Pomeroy, and Ball.

Chairman Ball thereupon announced that the matters to be studied would be assigned later.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the meeting was adjourned.
