All members present except Senators Saar and Ball

Chairman, Norman E. Gaar, called to committee to order.

Appearing before the Committee was Richard B. Hanger, recent appointee by the Governor to the State Board of Retirement. A copy of Mr. Hanger's resume' is attached.

At the conclusion of Mr. Hanger's presentation, he was dismissed by the Committee. The Committee then voted, by roll call, to confirm Mr. Hanger's appointment. All members voting aye. The motion to confirm was made by Sen. Pomeroy, seconded by Sen. Shultz.

Senator Foster explained Senate Bill 475, to the Committee. At the conclusion of the presentation, Senator Robinson made a motion to recommend SB 475, favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Senator Hinchey. All members voting aye, the motion carried.

Senator Gaar instructed Senator Thomas to present the resolution he had prepared on unfair accounting and reporting to the chair. Senator Gaar then read the resolution to the Committee. On a motion by Senator Pomeroy, seconded by Sen. West, it was agreed to introduce it as a Committee Resolution.
