COMMITTEE ON STATE AND LOCAL AFFAIRS

All members present except Senators Gaar, Herd and Ball

Vice Chairman Elwaine Pomeroy called the Committee to order.

Mr. John Corkhill appeared before the committee to explain Senate Bills, No. 397, 415, 416, 477, 538, 473, 470 and 576. Action on the bills as follows:

- S.B. 397 - Motion to pass, Shultz, Second Hinchey, carried.
- S.B. 415 - Motion to pass, Thomas, Second Hinchey, carried.
- S. B. 416 - Motion to pass, West, Second Shultz, carried.
- S.B. 477 - Motion to pass, Thomas, Second Hinchey, carried.
- S.B. 538 - Motion to pass, Thomas, Second Shultz, carried.
- S.B. 473 - Motion to amend, Shultz, Second Foster, carried

Amendment: On page 2, in line 17, by inserting before the word "parent" the word "dependent"; in line 19, by inserting before the word "parent" the word "dependent";

Motion to pass as amended, Thomas, second Robinson, carried.

- S.B. 470 - Motion to pass, Thomas, second Robinson, carried.
- S. B. 576 - Motion to amend, Shultz, second Hinchey, carried.

Amendment: On page 3, line 9 by inserting after the word "regard", the following: "to speculation but in regard"; on page 5 in line 4 by striking the following, "and in clause (c)" and in line 5 by striking the words "of subsection (7)", and in line 11 by striking the "comma" and inserting in lieu thereof a "period" and in line 11 following the period strike the word "the" and insert in lieu thereof the word "The".

Motion to pass as amended, Foster, second Hinchey, all members voting aye except Senator Thomas who voted no.

H.B. 1573 - Senator West informed the Committee that he, Senator Gaar and Senator Hinchey had prepared a substitute bill for H.B. 1573 that they wished to be introduced as a Committee bill. Said bill to be referred back to the Committee for study. On a motion by Senator West, seconded by Sen. Saar, it was voted to introduce it as a Committee bill and ask that it be referred back to Committee
