MINUTES

COMMITTEE ON STATE AND LOCAL AFFAIRS

All members present except: Senators Shultz, Herd, Foster & Gaar

Vice Chairman, Elwaine Pomeroy, called the Committee to order.

Senate Bill No. 256

On a motion by Senator Thomas, seconded by Senator Hinchey, it was voted to amend the bill by striking all of sections 1 thru 6, 8-14, 16-21 and renumbering the remaining sections, and correcting the title accordingly. On a motion by Sen. Thomas, seconded by Sen. Hinchey, it was voted to recommend, to the full Senate for passage, the bill as amended.

SCR 42

On a motion by Sen. Robinson, seconded by Sen. Thomas, it was voted to amend SCR 42 by striking on page 1, line 7, "1972" and inserting "1971" and correcting the title accordingly. On a motion by Sen. Thomas, seconded by Sen. Hinchey, it was voted to recommend SCR 42, as amended, to the full Senate for favorable passage.

Senate Bill No. 120

On a motion by Senator Robinson, Seconded by Senator Thomas, it was voted to recommend that SB 120, not be passed to the full Senate.

Senate Bill No. 361

Sen. Hinchey made a motion to the Committee that they recommend SB 361 unfavorably to the Full Senate. The motion was seconded by Sen. Robinson. Sen. West offered a substitute motion that the Committee recommend it favorable for passage. Sen. West's motion failed for lack of a second. Sen. Hinchey withdrew his original motion.

Senate Bill No. 461


On a motion by Senator Robinson, Seconded by Sen. Thomas, it was voted to amend the bill by changing the figure (100,000) to (160,000) and (175,000) to (185,000) and the words accompanying same accordingly. On a motion by Senator Thomas, seconded by Sen. Hinchey, it was voted to recommend the bill, as amended, for passage.

Except as otherwise noted, the individual remarks recorded herein have been as recommended verbatim and this record has been approved by the committee or by the individuals making such remarks.

Senator Saar was instructed by the Committee to prepare a resolution covering the areas of S. B. 474, and make a report on same to the Committee.
