Mr. Noble Drake representing the Kansas Retail Council, Mr. Harold Stones representing Kansas Bankers Association, Mr. Bob Chenoweth representing the Commercial National Bank of Kansas City, Kansas, Mr. William H. Stanley representing the Commercial National Bank of Kansas City, Kansas. Mr. Bob Chenoweth offered an amendment to House Bill 1900.

On Page 4, Line 16, after the word "cycle.", the following be inserted. "The use of the method referred to in K.S.A. 1971 Supp. 16-903 as the average daily balance shall be deemed and understood to meet the requirements of this subsection."

Representative Jelinek moved that House Bill 1982 be reported adversely - motion seconded by Representative Wilson - motion carried.

The opponents testimony was heard on House Substitute for House Bill 2050.
