S.B. #394 is hereby amended. Senator Herd moved S.B. #394 be recommended for passage as amended. Senator Robinson seconded the motion. Vote taken 10-0. Senate Bill #394 is recommended for passage as amended.

Senate Bill #427 was discussed by Senator Foster. He would like this bill to be debated in the Senate, feeling it would restore lost confidence in government. Senator Gaar appointed a sub-committee to examine the bill and report to the committee for serious consideration. The sub-committee is to consist of Senator Foster as Chairman, with Senators Saar and West as coworkers.

Senate Bill #130 will be discussed at the next meeting.

Pari-Mutuel Bill was dismissed by Chairman Gaar until Senator Robinson announces this is ready for consideration.

Senate Bill #494 discussed. Senator Gaar requested Senator Thomas to explain this bill to the committee in the middle of next week.
