<u>Senate Bill No. 550</u> - Mentally ill persons. Paul Purcell reviewed the bill. Committee discussion followed.

Senate Bill No. 553 - Juvenile Code Revision.

Art Griggs reviewed the bill. Mr. Griggs also reviewed some of the background information presented to the interim committee. Committee discussion followed.
