House Bill 2797 - Clean up compulsory process act. Following committee discussion, Senator Berman moved to strike section 2 and renumber the remaining sections; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

<u>House Bill 2709</u> - Crimes, contributing to misconduct or deprivation of a child and aggravated juvenile delinquency. Following review of the former committee actions on the bill, and further committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably; Senator Hess seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

House Bill 2713 - Uniform child custody jurisdiction act. Following committee discussion, Senator Everett moved to amend the bill to make it effective on January 1, 1979; Senator Simpson seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Simpson moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Hess seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

House Bill 2712 - Sub. for HB 2712; Crimes and criminal procedure, presentence reports, sentencing, probation conditions, parole eligibility, transfer of probation and parole functions, DOC and KAA regulations. Action on the bill was deferred until staff could present an explanation of the bill, at the 11:00 meeting of the committee.
