Senator Simpson passed out proposed amendments to the bill and explained the amendments. He moved the amendments be adopted; Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Simpson moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Mulich seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill No. 442 - Violation of traffic laws, giving of appearance bond or deposit of driver's license. Following committee discussion, Senator Hein moved to report a substitute bill dealing with the interstate compacts. Committee discussion followed, and staff was directed to obtain more information on the subject and report back.

Senate Bill No. 440 - County payments to state to assist in paying district court personnel costs. Senator Parrish related he had discussed this further with Mr. Schultz, and with Senators Hess and Gaines. They would like to have the bill reported favorably, but suggested that the bill be rereferred to Ways and Means Committee for further action, since that committee will be dealing with many aspects of court financing, and this deals with one part of it. Senator Parrish moved that the chairman request such rereferral; Senator Hein seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill No. 326 - Relinquishment of illegitimate children. Jerry Stephens discussed the relinquishment procedures in the statutes. Senator Hein moved to report the bill favorably; Senator Simpson seconded the motion. It was pointed out that in line 31 the word "a" should be changed to "the". Senator Hein moved to amend the bill in that manner; Senator Parrish

seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Senator Hein moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Following further committee discussion, Senator Hein moved to reconsider the action of the committee; Senator Berman seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Following further committee discussion, no further action was taken on the bill at this time.

Senate Bill No. 295 - Joint custody of children of divorced parents. Following committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to amend the bill on page 3 with regard to cooperative arrangements between the parents; Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Following further committee discussion, Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably as amended; Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned.
