Representative Jayne Aylward made a motion that House Bill 2020 be reported favorable for passage. Representative King seconded the motion. House Bill 2020 would suspend all statutory fund and aggregate levy limitations on taxing subdivisions and would authorize an increase in such limits sufficient for the taxing unit to raise the same amount of revenue as authorized in 1982. The motion carried. Representative Roe voted "Yes" and Representatives Lowther and Erne voted "No".

Discussion was held on House Concurrent Resolution No. 5009 which would amend Article 11, Section 1 of the Kansas Constitution to classify the property tax by January 1, 1989, or when the reappraisal is complete.

Representative Leach made a motion to amend HCR 5009 to leave out farm machinery due to the fact that it is already exempt. Representative Schmidt seconded the motion.

Representative Rolfs made a substitute motion that HCR 5009 be adopted. Representative Ott seconded the motion. The motion failed.
