The meeting of the House Governmental Organization Committee was called to order by Rep. Stephen R. Cloud, Chairman, at 9:04 a.m. The minutes of the January 25 meeting were approved. The January 27 minutes and the Agenda for the week of February 7 were passed out.

On being asked by the Chairman for any comments, several Committee members responded on the overwhelming aspect of many areas involved in the subcommittees. The Chairman responded by suggesting that each subcommittee define what is going to be done, set priorities and work within a time frame for the most productive use of time.

Chairman Cloud introduced Jamie Swartz, Secretary, Department of Economic Development. Mr. Swartz said that there are seven divisions within a forty person department. The reason for Mr. Swartz appearing before the Committee today was to request the Committee to introduce a bill that would amend K.S.A. 74-5008b and thereby abolish the division of research and publications and the office of the director thereof, but retain the persons employed to perform other duties. In addition, the bill would amend K.S.A. 74-5005 by striking therefrom the statutorily required duty of the department to analyze freight rates. Avis Swartzman, Revisor, stated that these two requests could be accomplished in one bill with the correct wording doing what Mr. Swartz has recommended. (See Attachment)

Rep. Matlack moved that a bill be drafted, containing the proper language that would comply with Mr. Swartz's requests. Rep. Louis gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The Chairman stated that the hearing on HCR 5014, concerning the abstracters' board of examiners, will be held February 8. Also, three or four more bills might be generated in the future from the Rules and Regulations Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:18 a.m.
