The meeting of the House Governmental Organization Committee was called to order at 8:08 a.m. by Rep. Stephen R. Cloud, Chairman. The minutes of the April 8 meeting were approved. The Chairman stated his appreciation for the members attendance at this meeting.

SCR 1613 - concerning trade practices for alcoholic beverages

Rep. Duncan returned to the Committee and reviewed his presentation of April 20 for the Committee members who were unable to attend at that time. Rep. Duncan explained regulations 14-1-1, 14-10-1, 14-10-la, 14-10-lb and 14-10-2. All of these regulations deal with point of sale materials. If this bill is passed, the stricken type is in and the other type out. Rep. Sughrue moved to adopt SCR 1613 favorable for passage. Rep. Murphy gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The Committee turned its attention to SB 41, concerning the Board of Healing Arts extension. Avis Swartzman, Revisor, passed out copies of the amendment that had been requested. The Chairman commented on what the amendment accomplishes. Rep. Fuller moved to adopt the amendment to SB 41. Rep. Ediger gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

After further Committee discussion, Rep. Ediger moved to pass SB 41 favorably as amended. Rep. Walker gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The next item of business was the audit report on the Department of Revenue, Driver Control Regulatory Program. Robin Hunn, Audit Supervisor, gave her presentation and answered several questions from Committee members. Rep. Smith moved that an interim study be made of the driver control problem and the uninsured motorist problem. Rep. Sughrue gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

The Chairman stated that the Committee can review these recommendations in 1984. The Chairman also stated that a copy of the Recommendations and Legislative Responses Relating To Sunset Audit Reports Reviewed by 1983 Legislature, prepared by Carolyn Rampey, would be made available to all Committee members. Also, copies of the letters of response from agency heads can be made available upon request by any Committee member. The minutes of April 20 and 21 will be approved if no corrections are made known to the Chairman's office.

Expressions of mutual appreciation were conveyed between the Chairman and Committee for the efforts made and work accomplished this session.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:03 a.m.
