SB 402 - AN ACT concerning counties; relating to civic centers; amending K.S.A. 19-15, 139, as amended by section 1 of 1983 House Bill No. 2025, and repealing the existing section.

Representative Acheson was present to give background and intent of the legislation. It deals with authorization for civic centers and expands it to include reconstruction, repair, remodeling, furnishing, and equipping of a civil and other multi-use public facility.
