The meeting was called to order at  $2\!:\!07$  p.m. by Chairman Crowell. Minutes of February 2, 3, 7, 8, and 9, 1983 were distributed, along with the Agenda.

Mr. Harold Turntine, Kansas Department of Revenue, explained to the committee the intent of  $\underline{SB\ 308}$ .  $\underline{SB\ 308}$  takes out the option of vehicle and mobile home dealers using an indemnifying bond instead of an insurance policy to cover their business operations in Kansas. In the insurance law it requires dealers to have insurance without the option of an in lieu of indemnifying bond.

The Chairman opened the meeting to committee questions and discussion. Chairman Crowell asked if  $\underline{SB\ 308}$  was just a clean up bill. Mr. Turntine stated it was.

Rep. Dempsey asked Mr. Turntine when the present law was enacted. Mr. Turntine replied in 1974.

Mr. Carman clarified and stated the law had been erroneously enacted twice since 1974.
