The Chairman called the meeting to order.

Representative Bill Bunten testified in favor of HB 2043, stating that this bill would require political action parties to fully disclose who they are. Representative Bunten also stated that the amendment made on the House floor by Representative Vic Miller was to change the \$50 amount of expenditure to be reported to \$25.

Ms. Carol Williams testified in favor of HB 2043, stating that the Commission favors this measure, and that the Senate had passed a bill similar to HB 2043 last year, but it died in the House Elections Committee. She also stated that the Commission has no position on the House Committee of the Whole amendment.

Ms. Williams passed out to the committee a list of registered political action committees as of January 25, 1983. (Attachment 1) She stated that if this bill passes, the word "None" would not appear under Affiliation.

Questions were asked and a general discussion was held.

Representative Edgar Moore testified in favor of HB 2177, stating that this measure was requested by the Johnson County Election Commissioner. Representative Moore said that the Election Commissioner's printing computer will not print squares, but will print parentheses, and that the Commissioner said that this measure would have saved \$8,000 in Johnson County's last election.

Questions were asked and a general discussion was held.

Mr. Chris McKenzie testified in favor of HB 2015, and gave some background information about the bill. Mr. McKenzie stated that this measure would eliminate protest petitions being alive for indefinite periods of time by amending K.S.A. 25-3602 to require the petitions to be filed within 90 days of the date of the first signature.

Questions were asked and a general discussion was held.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly to amend HB 2043 to strike the \$25 expenditure to be reported and insert \$50, and to make a clean up amendment in line 30 of the bill. Senator Gannon seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly and seconded by Senator Meyers to report  ${\tt HB}\ 2043$  as amended favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Meyers and seconded by Senator Reilly to report HB 2177 favorably. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Reilly to amend HB 2015 by striking Kansas register Unless specifically noted, the individual remarks recorded herein have not been transcribed verbatim. Individual remarks as reported herein have not
