The committee met for the purpose of continuing its consideration of $\underline{\text{S.B.}}$ 155, addressing creation of sewer districts and powers of governing bodies.

Senator Ehrlich moved to amend New Sec. 4, subsection (b) of the bill to provide that a petition requesting creation of a sewer district shall be signed by (1) at least 51% of the resident landowners or others having expressly reserved the right to do so, or (2) the owners of at least 51% of the acreage of land in the proposed district. Senator Mulich seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

Senator Bogina moved to amend New Sec. 5, subsection (b) to make it applicable statewide. Senator Winter seconded the motion, and it carried.

Senator Gaar suggested further amendments including conversion of New Sec. 6 to a notice section and addition of a new subsection in New Sec. 8. Senator Gaar indicated he will put his suggested amendments in draft form for consideration by the committee on March 8, 1983.

The meeting was adjourned to March 3, 1983.
