Chairperson Harper called the Elections Committee meeting to order, and announced that the committee had two bills scheduled for a hearing today.

HB 2722 - An Act relating to elections; concerning state committees of political parties; concerning alternate members, was first on the agenda for hearing. Chairperson Harper called upon Representative Hensley, the author of this bill, to give a brief explanation and the intent of his bill.

HB 2811 - An Act relating to elections; concerning withdrawal from nomination. Chairperson Harper turned the floor over to Representative Guldner, a cosponsor of this bill. The Representative told the members that this bill had been in the committee during the 1983 session, and stated that this bill was actually a substitute candidate bill. At this time, Representative Guldner turned the meeting over to Representative Heinemann, who also was a co-sponsor. Representative Heinemann testified before the committee giving his reasons for the bill, and stating some of his experiences when he was running for election.

Following a general discussion, the Chairperson called upon Representative Mainey, the third co-sponsor, to give a brief overview of HB 2811.
