TESTIMONY OF: STATE BANK COMMISSIONER EUGENE C. HEGARTY KANSAS BANKING DEPARTMENT ON SB 526 & SB 527

PRESENTED TO: THE SENATE COMMERCIAL & FINANCIAL INSTITUTION COMMITTEE

FEBRUARY 2, 1984

SB 526

MR. CHAIRMAN IT IS REQUESTED WE AMEND LINES 20, 24, 28, 30, 32, 35 AND 49 TO INSERT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE WORD "BANK" IN EACH CASE TO READ "BANK OR TRUST COMPANY". THIS AMENDMENT WAS REQUESTED BY THE BANKING BOARD AS THE WAY THE STATUTE NOW READS THE BOARD IS NOT CHARGED WITH INQUIRING INTO THE EFFECT OF THE CITY OR TOWN THAT BANK IS CURRENTLY LOCATED IN BUT ONLY THE TOWN OR CITY WHERE BANK DESIRES TO MOVE. THE BOARD FEELS THIS AMENDMENT SHOULD RECEIVE FAVORABLE CONSIDERATION.

SB 527

THE CHANGE INITIATED BY THIS BILL WOULD REQUIRE THAT ANY BANK DESIRING TO MAKE A PREPAYMENT OF ANY OF THEIR CAPITAL NOTES, WHICH HAD TO BE APPROVED BY THE STATE BANK-ING BOARD PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED, WOULD NEED THE STATE BANK COMMISSIONER'S APPROVAL.
