Following a call to order by Chairman Joseph C. Harder, <u>Senator Warren</u> moved, and <u>Senator Parrish seconded a motion to approve minutes of the Committee meeting of February 6. The motion carried.</u>

When the Chairman asked for the Committee's pleasure regarding SB 475, Senator Angell made a motion to amend SB 475 by delaying implementation of the fiscal provisions of SB 475 until the 1985-86 school year. This motion was seconded by Senator Montgomery, and the amendment was adopted.

Senator Montgomery made a conceptual motion to amend the bill whereby USD's which have extraordinary pay plans for professional employees in place by the 1984-85 school year would be allowed to use them without the fiscal provisions. Senator Angell seconded the motion to amend the bill, and the amendment was adopted. The Revisor, however, stated that this amendment was not needed, since the funding will not be implemented until the 1985-86 school year. Committee members, however, stated that they did not wish to discourage any school districts which have extraordinary pay plans for professional employees in place by the commencement of the 1984-85 school year from utilizing them.

Senator Montgomery moved, and Senator Angell seconded the motion that SB 475, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried. Senator Rehorn and Senator Parrish requested that their nay votes be recorded.

<u>SB 635</u> - When the Chairman asked the Committee's pleasure regarding SB 635, <u>Senator Kerr moved</u>, and <u>Senator Allen seconded the motion to report</u> <u>SB 635 adversely</u>. <u>The motion carried</u>.

<u>SB 630</u> - When the Chairman asked the Committee's pleasure regarding SB 630, Senator Kerr moved, and Senator Allen seconded the motion to report SB 630 adversely. The motion carried.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting.
