Motion was made by Senator Norvell to report \underline{SB} 787 favorably. Senator Talkington seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Norvell to amend \underline{SB} 789 by inserting "service as a judge or clerk on an election board" in line 74, and to change "they/theirs" to "such voter" in lines 73 and 74. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Norvell to report $\underline{SB\ 789}$ favorably as amended. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Meyers and seconded by Senator Talkington to amend \underline{SB} 790 by deleting "for" and inserting "with" in line 39, and by deleting "registered" and inserting "affiliated" in line 39. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Talkington and seconded by Senator Johnston to report \underline{SB} 790 favorably as amended. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Talkington and seconded by Senator Johnston to report \underline{SB} $\underline{791}$ favorably and to request it be placed on the Consent Calendar. The motion was adopted.

Mr. Eric Rucker testified on \underline{SB} 804, stating that the enactment of this bill would mandate that all petitions include withdrawl instructions on its face.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Norvell to amend $\underline{SB}\ 804$ by inserting "excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays" in line 43 and wherever needed. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Hayden to report <u>SB 804</u> favorably as amended. The motion was adopted.

Mr. Eric Rucker testified on $\underline{SB\ 811}$, stating that this bill would prohibit a local officer from resigning once a recall election has been called.

Questions were asked and a general discussion was held.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Hayden to amend $\underline{SB\ 811}$ by amending K.S.A. 25-4328 to give the county election commissioner the authority to cancel a recall election in the event of the local officer's resignation prior to the recall election. The motion was adopted.

Motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Hayden to report $\underline{\text{SB 811}}$ favorably as amended. The motion was adopted.
