H.B. 3095 - Solid waste resource recovery facilities provided by counties and cities

Senator Feleciano moved that the bill be amended by striking the phrase "except that any materials having value as a source of energy generation may not be extracted therefrom" from lines 62-64. Senator Hess seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Hess made a conceptual motion that the bill be amended to provide that the cost of the refuse service cannot exceed the highest fee charged for such service in that municipality. Senator Feleciano seconded the motion. After discussion, the motion and second were withdrawn.

Senator Hess made a conceptual motion that the bill be amended to provide that the local governing body has the authority to set rates for the refuse service. Senator Vidricksen seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Feleciano moved that "30" be inserted in place of "10" in line 185 of the bill. Senator Hess seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Hess made a conceptual motion that references to municipalities be deleted from lines 110, 121, 132, 140, 141, 155 and 162 and that a new subsection (h) be inserted after line 192 as follows: "This section shall not apply to solid waste disposed of as a part of a city solid waste management program operated directly or pursuant to contract.". Senator Feleciano seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Hess moved that the bill, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. Senator Vidricksen seconded the motion, and the motion failed on a 4-4 vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35 a.m. by the Chairman.
