The Chairman called the Committee's attention to the Minutes of the Meetings before it. Senator Gannon moved that the Minutes of January 24, February 22, 23, 24 and 28 be approved. 2d by Senator Morris. Motion carried.

The Chairman directed the Committee's attention to the subject of bingo. He said that $\underline{SB401}$ is still on the Governor's desk, and that the floor is open for continued discussion on $\underline{SB770}$, concerning bingo. Senator Francisco said that Paul Hess said that Ways and Means will set a hearing for SB770 after this Committee takes action and makes a recommendation.

Mr. Wilkes had suggested clean-up amendments to the bill. Senator Meyers moved the amendments be adopted. 2d by Senator Gannon. Motion carried. The Revisor's Office will will see that the proper language is made a part of the proposed legislation.

Senator Winter made a conceptual motion for amendment to make the limitations of officers, et cetera, to apply also to any organization that leases or is the lessor of the premises. 2d by Senator Francisco. Senator Winter withdrew the motion.

Then a motion was made by Senator Francisco, 2d by Senator Meyers, on Page 8, line 280, of the bill to remove the words "within 5 years prior to registration" and to put it into SB770. Motion failed.

Senator Morris moved that SB770 as amended be reported without recommendation. 2d by Senator Roitz.

Senator Winter made a substitute motion to provide that no premises shall be used for management, conduct or operation of bingo games more than any six consecutive days in one calendar week, and also conceptually to limit the number of people who may play on those premises to no more than 200 people. If the premises hold more than that they may operate only 3 days a week. 2d by Senator Morris. Senator Francisco made the conceptual motion to amend the substitute motion to "no more than 250 people." 2d by Senator Winter. The substitute motion as amended carried.

Senator Morris then moved that SB770 as amended be reported without recommendation. 2d by Senator Gannon. Senator Francisco made the substitute motion that SB770 be reported favorably as amended. 2d by Senator Daniels. Substitute motion failed. Vote was taken on the original motion and it carried, that SB770 as amended be reported without recommendation.

The meeting was adjourned at noon.
