Senator Allen moved to approve the minutes of the January 25, 1984 meeting. Senator Parrish seconded the motion and it carried.

Senator Montgomery opened the hearing on  $\underline{\text{S.B. }565}$ , which would permit improvement districts in unincorporated areas to purchase or acquire emergency warning siren systems. Mrs. Gerry Ray spoke in support of the bill.
