Conferees appearing before the committee:

The committee reviewed the Senate Bills remaining in the committee. No action was taken.

A discussion of the House Bills before the committee followed, and the following action was taken:

<u>H.B. 2608</u>, extending the time cities have to publish quarterly financial statements from 20 to 30 days - <u>Senator Parrish moved to report the bill favorably for passage. <u>Senator Montgomery seconded the motion and it carried by a unanimous vote</u>. <u>Senator Gaar asked Senator Daniels to carry the bill.</u></u>

H.B. 2826, requiring tax levies to be stated in terms of a rate in dollars upon each \$1,000 instead of \$100 of assessed valuation - Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Parrish seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Senator Montgomery was asked to carry the bill.

Senator Gaar asked Senator Daniels to check with the sponsor of $\underline{\text{H.B. }2344}$ to determine if the legislation had been incorporated into another bill.

Senator Daniels moved to approve the minutes of the February 28, 1984, meeting. Senator Montgomery seconded the motion and it carried.
