SB 660 - Concerning dentists; improper use of name; suspension or revocation of license

Senator Morris moved that SB 660 be amended by introducing a substitute bill for 660. Senator Johnston seconded the motion.

There was discussion concerning franchising and alleged violations of the law by the Dental Board.

Chairman Meyers called for the motion before them to adopt this bill as a substitute bill for SB 660. The motion carried.

Senator Francisco moved that a New Section 2 be added to the new bill saying that violation of any provision of this act by the Dental Board will subject the Board of disciplinary action. The motion was seconded.

There was discussion concerning how to apply penalties to Boards for violating the law. It was decided to have Norman Furse, Revisor of Statutes office research this matter for consideration later.

SB 640 - Program for treatment of hemophilia

There was discussion concerning funding of the program.

Senator Johnston moved that SB 640 be amended by saying "within the limits of the appropriation". Senator Chaney seconded the motion and it carried.

<u>Senator Johnston moved that SB 640 be reported favorably, as amended.</u>
<u>Senator Chaney seconded the motion</u>.

Senator Fhrlich offered a substitute motion that the amendments recommended by Barbara Sabol, Secretary, DH&E, be adopted. Senator Johnston seconded the motion and it carried.

Senator Johnston moved that SB 640 be reported favorably, as amended. Senator Chaney seconded the motion and it carried.

 $\underline{\text{SB }660}$ - Norman Furse read to the committee the penalty for violation of the penal statute, and procedure for ouster.

SB 488 - Limitations on powers of guardians

Senator Meyers stated that this bill was re-referred to the committee
