The Chairman opened the meeting by recognizing Ben Barrett from the Legislative Research Department on staff who presented the committee with a summary of the main features of HB 2144, the SDEA package for 1985. (ATTACHMENT 1)

Representative Leach presented the committee with a copy of a computer run utilizing a budget authority of 5 - 10%. (ATTACHMENT 2) This printout includes sixty million dollars additional state aid in the general fund, allowing a teacher salary increase on the average of 8.8%, and raising the property taxes approximately \$26,463,000 statewide.

Representative Apt presented the committee with a copy of a computer run utilizing a budget authority of 4 - 8%. (ATTACHMENT 3) This printout includes thirty million dollars additional state aid in the general fund over the previous year, and raising property taxes statewide approximately \$47,133,000.

Representative Brady presented the committee with a copy of a computer run utilizing a budget authority of 3 - 6% plus an additional 2% authority for teacher salaries. (ATTACHMENT 4) This printout includes forty-five million dollars additional state aid in the general fund, with a teacher salary increase potential in excess of 9%, and raising property tax statewide approximately \$35,883,000.

Representative Leach made a motion to amend HB 2144 to change the budget authority to 5 - 10% with \$60 million additional state aid in the general fund. Representative Brady seconded the motion. The motion was declared lost on a voice vote. On call of a division, the vote was nine for the amendment and twelve against.

Representative Brady moved to amend HB 2144 by changing the budget authority to 3 - 6% with an additional 2% authority for teachers salaries and an additional \$45 million in additional state aid in the general fund. Representative Bowden seconded the motion. The motion was declared lost on a voice vote. On call of a division, eight supported the amendment and twelve opposed.

Representative Apt moved to amend HB 2144 by changing the budget authority to 4 - 8% with an additional \$30 million in state aid in the general fund, also by figuring the effect of the booster tax the same as figured in the 1984-85 school year. Representative Moomaw seconded the motion.

Representative Leach made a substitute motion to amend HB 2144 by changing the budget authority to 5 - 10% and including \$45 million in additional state aid in the general fund. Representative Branson seconded the motion. The motion was declared lost on a voice vote. On call of a division, nine supported the amendment and ten opposed.

The question reverted to the original motion of Representative Apt. The Chairman declared the motion carried on a voice vote. On call of a division, eleven supported the motion and ten opposed. Representatives Baker, Bowden, Brady, Branson, Harder, Hensley and Reardon were recorded as voting no.

Representative Apt moved that HB 2144 be reported favorably as amended. Representative Hassler seconded the motion.

Representative Miller made a substitute motion to amend HB 2144 by deleting the provision for counting certain preschool handicapped children, and the provision for depositing interest earned in the capital outlay fund to the general fund. Representative Moomaw seconded the motion.

Unless specifically noted, the individual remarks recorded herein have not been transcribed verbatim. Individual remarks as reported herein have not been submitted to the individuals appearing before the committee for editing or corrections.

The Chairman then asked that the second part of the motion be discussed and voted on. The question to delete the provision for depositing interest earned in the capital outlay fund to the general fund. The motion lost on a vote of eight to ten.

The question reverted to reporting HB 2144 favorably as amended. The motion was adopted. Representatives Reardon, Bowden and Baker were recorded as voting no.

The Chairman turned the Committee's attention to SB 124, amending laws pertaining to the State Advisory Council for Vocational Education.

Representative Miller moved that SB 124 be reported favorably and placed on the Consent Calendar. Representative Hensley seconded the motion. The motion was adopted.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:33 p.m.

SUMMARY OF MAIN FEATURES OF 1985 H.B. 2144

Section 1 The amendments expand the definition of "pupil" for purposes of the SDEA to count in a school district's enrollment certain preschool-aged handicapped children who are being provided special education services. Any such child enrolled in the district on September 15 who is at least four years old but who is not old enough to attend kindergarten (age 5 on September 1) is counted as 0.5 pupil in the district's enrollment.

Section 2 For the 1985-86 school year, taxable income, for purposes of determining district wealth under the SDEA, is based on the taxable income of resident individuals determined under the Kansas income tax act with modifications to the Kansas itemized deduction that were in effect for the taxable year ending prior to January 1, 1983.

This provision eliminates the effect of the "booster tax" (1983 S.B. 436) on the computation of district wealth for the 1985-86 school year.

Section 3 An amendment sets school district per pupil budget controls for the 1985-86 school year at 106 percent to 112 percent.

Another amendment provides that interest earned on the school district's capital outlay fund and deposited in the district's general fund becomes a part of the district's general fund budget base (and, therefore, is equalized) in 1986-87 and thereafter. (See discussion below of Section 4.)

Section 4 The amendments permit school districts, for the 1985-86 school year only, to deposit interest earned in the capital outlay fund to the school district general fund. Any such interest is not subject to the 1985-86 per pupil budget controls; it must be used for operating expenses in that year.
