Beverly Bradley, representing the Kansas Association of Counties, indicated the association's number one priority is to increase pledging of securities of public funds from 70% to 100%. Attachment 1.

Mike Billinger also spoke in support of House Bill 2122 stating the bill would greatly enhance the comfort level of counties.

Jim Maag said House Bill 2122 would increase the required pledging to 100% for all deposits regardless of the rate paid and require that securities being pledged are at market value. He added that by moving the requirement to 100% pledging of public fund deposits, banks may find it difficult to pledge adequate securities to cover large public fund deposits.

Representative Wisdom moved to table House Bill 2122 until the committee receives additional information; seconded by Representative Peterson. The motion carried.
