Statement To
HOUSE AND SENATE COMMITTEES ON EDUCATION
Re: Ad Hoc Committee School Finance Proposal

Thursday, January 31, 1985

Topeka, Kansas

The Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance is made up of legislators and individuals (non-legislators) who are on the outside looking in each year when the Legislature wrestles with the topic of school finance. We want you to know that the proposal we are putting before you today does not represent what any one individual on the Ad Hoc Committee might have developed for a school finance formula. Parts of the proposal are acceptable to all the individuals on the Ad Hoc Committee. Some parts of it, frankly, are not the ingredients that some individual members would have proposed. Rather, the plan is a consensus proposal developed after countless hours of study, discussion, debate, and general agreement that a new direction for school finance is necessary. Individual members of the Ad Hoc Committee will want to describe where they agree and where they disagree with the component parts of this Ad Hoc Committee proposal. Attached you will find a list of the membership of the Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance.

We have watched the Legislator grapple with the topic of school finance for several years. In recent Legislative Sessions the School District Equalization Act (SDEA) has been the cause of increasingly acrimonious debate within Legislative Committees and on the floor of both Senate and House. The Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance was developed when some of us began talking first in 1979 about getting together various interest groups to sit down and see if something acceptable to diverse interests could be put together. We formalized our plans to do just that, and, in 1980, met for two days a month for several months before making an initial Ad Hoc Committee presentation to an Interim Committee of the Legislature. Our initial proposal came late in the deliberations of the Interim Committee, a Committee nearly ready to move with its own modifications of the SDEA. Several legislators came to us and told us that our plan had a great deal of merit. What is being presented to you today is refinement of that proposal geared to a school finance plan for Kansas based on balanced revenue from the sources available for funding our elementary and secondary schools.

In May, 1984, the Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance began again. At our initial meeting we discussed individual and organizational philosophies. We put our biases and "hidden agendas" on the table for all members to view, to hear, to discuss and examine. The result of those discussions is the proposal being submitted to you for consideration in the 1985 Session of the Kansas Legislature. We hope you find the proposal, or some portions of it, worthy of incorporation into the school finance law for the State of Kansas.

als of Ad Hoc Proposal Described

In our early meetings in 1984, members of the Ad Hoc Committee began by listing the strengths and weaknesses of the SDEA, the ingredients acceptable to most, and the shortcomings of the SDEA in the eyes of some. Discussion lead to the establishment of approximately four goals for any new plan for school finance in the State of Kansas. Those are as follows:

1. A balance in revenue sources,
2. A reduction in property taxes,
3. Recognition of differing expenditure levels among school districts of various sizes, and
4. State assistance for support of a "basic" educational program for EVERY DISTRICT.

The first and second goals are inseparably linked. Most of the discussion within and outside of legislative halls would indicate a need to find some different sources of revenue for school finance, and a need to reduce the reliance on the property tax.

When looking at figures presented almost annually to Legislative Committees by the Legislative Research Department and the Statistics and Finance section of the Department of Education, the inescapable conclusion is that the ad valorem property tax is still used as a major source of revenue for state and local government. The major sources of revenue are, of course, the "big three" money producers: the property tax, the income tax, and the sales tax. Far and away the largest source of revenue for local units of government including Unified School Districts, is the property tax. One goal, then, of the Ad Hoc Committee was to bring those figures toward a greater balance.

Aside from the EBF and institutional use of a small property tax levy, the state does not make a major claim on the property tax. The Ad Hoc Committee believes the state should not derive its revenues from the property tax.

The range of expenditures per pupil . . . low to high . . . in this state is from approximately \$1,989 to \$6,028. Generally, the higher expenditures per pupil are in the lower enrollment categories. However, some of the largest school districts in the State of Kansas have per pupil expenditures significantly higher than the mid-range of enrollment categories. The Ad Hoc Committee did not attempt to justify for large or small districts the expenditures per pupil when developing a new finance proposal. The reasons for those expenditures are perhaps best known within individual districts, though the Education Committees of the Legislature may want to examine the whys of expenditures per pupil in all school districts.

The Ad Hoc Committee School Finance proposal attempts to modestly fund a portion of the basic education program for every school district in the state by an initial state aid entitlement. In the proposal being advanced to you today there are no no-aid school districts.

Ad Hoc Committee Proposal Described

With the above stated goals in mind, the Ad Hoc Committee has developed a formula and prepared a computer printout for that formula to show a school finance plan for the 1983-84 school year. One of our printouts shows a side-by-side comparison of state aid under the SDEA with the aids under a new proposal. We selected 1983-84 so that we would have the most recent, most complete, available information on sources of revenue, enrollments, and expenditures per pupil.

The basic ingredients of the Ad Hoc Committee proposal are these:

1. There would be a uniform property tax levy of 15 mills (we call it LEP . . . local effort property) against urban and rural real and personal property at its assessed value.
2. There would be a 1.5% tax on income (LEI . . . local effort income) on every resident individual in each school district. The tax would be against taxable income and would return to the district of origin.
3. Every school district would receive a flat grant initial state aid payment of \$400 per pupil.
4. For budget making purposes, there would be a per pupil guarantee, based on known expenditures per pupil by various enrollment categories, times district enrollment to provide a state-shared budget (SSB) in each of the school districts.
5. Revenues to fund the state's portion of the Ad Hoc Committee proposal would come from:
 - A. The state aid appropriation for the 83-84 school year,
 - B. A uniform 15 mill property tax levy against state assessed property,
 - C. A 1.5% tax on taxable income of corporations, banks, savings and loans, insurance companies, and non-resident individuals (to the extent such income is taxable in the State of Kansas), and
 - D. An increase in the sales and compensating use tax of 1%.

The dollar figures for these revenue sources is shown on page three of the 8½ x 11 handout that accompanies the computer printouts for the Ad Hoc Committee School Finance proposal.

The first two pages of our 8½ x 11 handout show a column-by-column explanation of the 18-column computer printout for the Ad Hoc School Finance proposal. We have added to our original 18-column printout two additional, unnumbered columns to show a side-by-side comparison of basic aid and additional guarantee provided in the 1983-84 school year.

We invite your attention to the computer printouts. It may be helpful if we now work our way through the Ad Hoc Committee plan. We will be happy to respond either as we go through the printout or at the conclusion of our presentation. We will be looking first at the 18-column printout and invite your attention to the first school district listed . . . Marmaton Valley, USD 256, in Allen Co. Marmaton Valley had, on September 15, 1983, an enrollment of 308.0 pupils. Since this district is under 400 in enrollment you will see on the 8½ x 11 sheet that this district, and any other district with a similar enrollment under 400, but greater than 200, would have a flat per pupil guarantee of \$3,450. The enrollment of 308.0 x the per pupil guarantee gives a State Shared Budget (SSB), shown in Column 3, of \$1,062,600 for Marmaton Valley.

Columns 4 and 5 show the local effort that would be made in Marmaton Valley. Marmaton Valley has \$678,945 of urban valuation, \$4,848,505 of rural valuation, \$3,127,340 of tangible personal (oil and gas) valuation, and \$2,672,385 of other personal valuation. (These valuations may be seen on printouts I and II).

The total assessed valuation available to Marmaton Valley is \$11,327,175. 15 mill levy times that urban and rural real and personal assessed valuation would produce for Marmaton Valley \$169,908 . . . the figure shown in Column 4. That is known as local effort on property (LEP). This school district has taxable income of \$7,402,931. The same kind of rate015 . . . or, said another way 1.5%, equals the local effort on income (LEI) for Marmaton Valley of \$111,044.

We indicated earlier the Ad Hoc Committee proposal provides some basic aid for every school district in the State of Kansas. We call this Initial State Aid (ISA). The Ad Hoc Committee proposal would fund Initial State Aid for all school districts in the State of Kansas at \$400 per pupil. Revenues for ISA come from a 1% increase in the sales and compensating use tax. ISA for Marmaton Valley would be \$123,200.

Column 7 is the total of the local effort on property, the local effort on income, and the initial state aid.

Column 8 we have headed Composite Wealth Factor (CWF). The Composite Wealth Factor is determined from an index table (p. 4 in our 8½ x 11 handout) showing an index of taxable income per pupil and assessed valuation per pupil, each index ranging from .80 to .20, with the mid-range in each index being .50. Said another way our goal is to have as many districts above 50% as below 50%. The index numbers for income per pupil and valuation per pupil . . . each a two digit number, are added together and divided by 2. Therefore, Marmaton Valley has a Composite Wealth Factor (CWF) of .33. The Composite Wealth Factor is multiplied times the State Shared Budget (SSB) in Column 3, to give us another form of state aid called State Shared Guarantee (SSG). The State Shared Guarantee is shown in Column 9. For Marmaton Valley, .33 (33%) of the State Shared Budget is \$350,658. Column 9a is called Adjusted Shared Guarantee (ASG). The adjustment made by the Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance, shown in Column 9a, reflects a 100% deduction from the State Shared Guarantee (SSG) of PL 874 monies. These federal funds accrue because of what is called federal impact aid to school districts near military installations where students of military personnel have an impact on the enrollment of the school district. In Marmaton Valley there is no deductions so Column 9a has the same figure . . . \$350,658 as its State Shared Guarantee. Marmaton Valley receives no PL 874 money.

Column 10 is a figure representing the State Shared Budget (Column 3) minus the Adjusted Shared Guarantee (ASG) in Column 9a. For Marmaton Valley that figure is \$711,942. From the figure in Column 10 you would subtract Column 7, which is the total of the local effort on property, local effort on income, and initial state aid of \$400 per pupil. That leaves you the figure shown in Column 11 which we have headed Additional Shared Budget.

If the Kansas Legislature were to accept the Ad Hoc Committee plan . . . were to accept the per pupil guarantee and therefore the State Shared Budget generated by the Ad Hoc Committee plan, Marmaton Valley "should be spending" the \$1,062,600 shown in Column 3 to provide an adequate education for the number of students enrolled. If that be so, then Column 11 . . . the Additional Shared Budget . . . represents the amount of money still needed . . . \$307,790 . . . to reach the State Shared Budget (Column 3).

The Ad Hoc Committee proposal, then, would have the state share in that additional budget requirement to the extent of the district's wealth. The Ad Hoc Committee plan would provide for 33% . . . the Composite Wealth Factor in Column 8 . . . to be multiplied times the Additional Shared Budget in

Column 11 to provide a third level of state aid. This third level or tier is labeled Additional Budget Guarantee, and is shown in Column 12. For Marmaton Valley, that additional guarantee is \$101,571.

In the Ad Hoc Committee proposal, after the district has made its 15 mill effort on assessed valuation, has the revenue from a 1.5% tax on taxable income of all of the resident individual patrons in the school district, and has received Initial State Aid (ISA) of \$400 per pupil (Column 6), the State Shared Guarantee in Column 9 . . . adjusted in Column 9a by PL 874 monies, and the Additional Budget Guarantee shown in Column 12, and is still short of the State Shared Budget figure in Column 3, there will be a need for additional local effort. The Ad Hoc Committee proposal is that it be a determination of the locally elected Board of Education whether those additional funds come from an additional property tax, an additional income tax, or a combination of the two. HOWEVER, for purposes of this printout and for ease of demonstration we have shown it as an additional property tax. In the case of Marmaton Valley the Additional Local Effort (Column 13) would be \$206,220. In the case of Marmaton Valley it would take 14.68 mills of additional property tax effort to complete the formula and fund the budget provided by the Ad Hoc Committee plan shown in Column 3.

IMPORTANT NOTE: For the additional mill levies, the Ad Hoc Committee proposes that all property within the school district be accessible if the district chooses to extend an additional property tax levy. In other words, whereas the local effort in Column 4 is only against urban and rural real and personal property at its assessed valuation, the additional levy would be against urban, rural, personal and state assessed valuation within the district. . . again, all of these at the assessed value as opposed to adjusted assessed valuation currently used in the SDEA. The rationale used in the Ad Hoc Committee for going to assessed valuation as opposed to adjusted assessed valuation is simply this: The assessed value is what is available at the local level against which the school district may levy. That valuation between assessed and adjusted assessed is "paper wealth."

In Column 14 of the Ad Hoc Committee School Finance printout you will see the Actual Budget for Marmaton Valley for the 1983-84 school year was \$1,164,610. Column 15 is headed Net Difference. If that figure is in brackets (as it is for Marmaton Valley), it means that the Ad Hoc Committee proposal generates a budget less than was actually budgeted by the school district for the 1983-84 school year.

The Legislature may want to say that in moving to a school finance proposal such as the one submitted to you by the Ad Hoc Committee on School Finance that no district shall be penalized by budgeting less than it did in 83-84 and for that reason we have shown in Column 17 that, if given permission to fund to the level of the Actual Budget for 1983-84 (Column 14) the increased levy for Marmaton Valley would be 21.94 mills. The 21.94 is added to the 15 mills in Column 4. It already includes the 14.68 mills shown in Column 16 to reach the State Shared Budget. It is not the addition of the 14.68 mills and 21.94 mills. The 21.94 includes the 14.68.

We have appreciated the opportunity to present the Ad Hoc Committee proposal for balanced funding for elementary and secondary schools in Kansas. We would point out to you some figures from the last page of the computer printout to show that balance. Local effort on property tax statewide under the Ad Hoc Committee plan would be \$134,386,908. Statewide the local effort on income tax would be \$138,134,632. Initial State Aid, derived from a 1% sales tax

ould provide \$154,311,000. We believe this plan achieves appropriate goals: balance in revenue sources, a significant reduction in property taxes, recognition of different expenditure levels among the school districts in Kansas, and state assistance for the very basic educational program of each and every school district in the state.
