The minutes of February 27 and 28 were approved by motion of Senator Martin and second by Senator Strict.

SB 220 - Senator Johnston, the author of the bill, stated that the House Committee on Elections is considering a similar bill and is scheduled to hold hearings tomorrow on House Bill 2535. He stated that under the present system of nominating our presidential candidates are chosen by party organization members and not the party as a whole and if government is to be a democratic process there should be people participation in selecting elected officials. The bill brief on SB 220 giving the background of other states who have had presidential primaries and listing the proponent and opponent arguments was explained by Myrta Anderson from the Legislative Research Department.

Horace Eubank, retired educator, an opponent of SB 220 said that he had taken a poll of 12 people in 20 different counties and not one approves of this bill. He stated that our election laws were established years ago and he thought that we could improve the system and bring it up to date.

Doug Mays also spoke in opposition to SB 220. Mr. Mays said he was speaking for himself and not for any particular group or organization. He said there is very little support in primaries and candidates really do not care whether we have a presidential primary and with this as the case we are wasting our time and money since no one wants it. He thought it would be best if the committee disposed of this bill rapidly and get on with more important issues.

Committee discussion followed and it was pointed out that maybe primaries were too expensive or maybe the turnout of voters was not strong enough. Another point that was brought out was that if all the states had primaries on the same day at the same time there might be some merit in having primary presidential elections.

A motion by Senator Martin and second by Senator Strict to report SB 220 favorably for passage was withdrawn on the request of Senator Johnston to wait the outcome of House Bill 2535 in the House Elections Committee since they have hearings scheduled for their next meeting.

 $\underline{\mathrm{SB}\ 315}$  - Eric Rucker from the Secretary of State's Office said the bill provides that any person desiring to be a write-in candidate at an election for a state or national office has to file a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate with the Secretary of State. The Secretary of State certifies the names of write-in

candidates to the county election officer at least ten days before a primary or general election. Mr. Rucker further stated that his office has no official stand on this bill but introduced it to bring it to the attention of the committee. A partial list of write-in candidates was distributed (<a href="Attachment No. 1">Attachment No. 1</a>) and it was pointed out that none of the write-in candidates ended up winning.

Senator Reilly moved to favorably recommend to the Senate passage of SB 315. Senator Strict seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The Chairman announced that at the next meeting the committee would consider HB 2184 and all remaining Senate bills in committee.

The meeting was adjourned.

In accordance with K.S.A. 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning Senate Bill No. 220 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Senate Bill No. 220 amends K.S.A. 25-4501 relating to the presidential preference primary in the state of Kansas. Senate Bill No. 220 would provide for a presidential preference primary election every four years.

The Office of the Secretary of State reports that the cost for a presidential preference primary election in 1980 was \$1,057,535. The Secretary of State estimates the cost for a presidential preference primary in 1988 at \$1.8 million. This amount was determined by applying the increase in the Consumer Price Index to the 1980 figure and estimating 1985, 1986, and 1987 at an 8.8 percent increase.
